Welcome! We are excited to have you join us for our March 2023 ISC and UKI Competition! Please notify the show managers of any errors in your entries or registration information as soon as possible at showmanager@daisypeel.com. A general briefing will be held after measurement and check-in.

IMPORTANT DETAILS:

- The property opens at 8am Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. DO NOT ARRIVE PRIOR TO THIS
 TIME. The gate will be CLOSED until 8am.
- Measuring (if needed) will start at 8:10am each day. For UKI: If you have a height card from another organization that has the actual height printed on it, it may be used to satisfy your measuring requirements if your dog is not within 1/8" of a UKI jump height cutoff. Dogs That need to be measured must be done before they run, and it is your responsibility to know if your dog needs a measurement. You can email an image or PDF of any height cards to showmanager@daisypeel.com to expedite this process on the day of the show.
- **TIMETABLE:** Judge's briefing will be at 8:30am each day, walkthroughs for the first class will begin at 8:45am each day, and first dog on the line at 9am each day.
- UKI ONLY DAY OF SHOW ENTRIES: Day of show entries (titling only) close at 8:30am Saturday. Absolutely no entries accepted after that time. If you think you may be interested in a day-of entry, we prefer that you email us your entry (showmanager@daisypeel.com) ahead of time to skip the line. That way IF you come on the day-of, you need only bring payment.
- **FOOD SERVICES:** There is no food on site, please plan accordingly.

CHECK YOUR ENTRIES!

Failure to do so can result in VOID scores. Show managers will NOT correct your information on site as we have way too many other things to process, so please email us (showmanager@daisypeel.com) PRIOR to the show for any corrections.

- UKI: Is your handler number correct?
- UKI/AKC: Is your dog number correct?
- UKI: Is your level for Speedstakes correct?
- UKI/AKC: Is your level for everything else correct?
- UKI/AKC: Is your dog's jump height correct?
- UKI/AKC: Is your dog in regular or select/preferred?

TRIAL SITE RULES:

- The show site is indoors on ARTIFICIAL TURF. Please bring your own crate, clean up supplies, & water for your dog.
- Spectator seating will be allowed in the first 15' of the arena. Dogs are not allowed on the turf unless they are running or queuing to run.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times, except when in the ring. Exercise and toilet your
 dog in designated areas. Please poop and scoop and use garbage containers on the site.
 Please be courteous to others using the area. No aggressive dogs.
- A warm up jump on turf will be provided for all exhibitors, located in the indicated stall.
 One dog in the warm up stall at a time.

- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so
 may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to
 be in violation of this requirement
- This is a NON SMOKING inside of the building or near the doors.
- No weapons of any kind, concealed or otherwise, are allowed on the premises.
- Please park ONLY in designated parking areas.

CRATING:

Crating is available inside the building in 10'x10' stalls. Dogs must be kenneled or crated while in the stalls. <u>Volunteers</u> will be given first priority for stall crating and stalls must be shared amongst competitors (plenty of room in each stall for multiple crates!!).

VOLUNTEERS:

 If you would like to volunteer please click <u>HERE</u> to go to the Google Spreadsheet for volunteers and sign up! We can't do it without you! Volunteers will receive vouchers for use at future UKI competitions or in the raffle we will have on site.

UNDERSTAND THE RULES FOR FEO/NFC:

You may turn any run into a FEO/NFC run, but must declare this before you start. You may use a toy or training aid (NO food). You may use this time for any type of training, as long as you are not abusive to your dog. A competition run that has been faulted may NOT be turned into an NFC run. SCT will be used. If a handler chooses to train their start line, the time will be started once the handler begins to walk back towards their dog once

they have left him. Scribe will announce when time is up and the handler MUST immediately exit the ring.

• The rules for FEO/NFC are slightly different for UKI and AKC so listen to the judge's briefing to know what is and is not allowed for each organization.

RESULTS / MAPS / RUN ORDERS:

- **COURSE MAPS** will only be released when doors open. In addition, maps will be emailed to competitors, posted on The Agility Challenge Acres FB page, and posted on the wall inside the Agility Challenge Arena in the crating area.
- RUN ORDERS Please see the attached tentative run orders. Any conflicts will have a 5
 minute maximum transition time between dogs. We can adjust run order via written
 corrections for conflicts in all other runs.

- Everyone (Exhibitors, Spectators, Volunteers, and Judges) visiting Agility Challenge Acres does so at their own risk.

- If you are ill, have a fever, cough, shortness of breath, fatigue, muscle aches, or new loss of taste or smell or have been exposed to someone who has, you must stay home.
