Welcome! We are excited to have you join us for our August 30th - September 1st , 2025 AKC ISC Competition! Please notify the show managers of any errors in your entries or registration information as soon as possible at showmanager@daisypeel.com. A general briefing will be held after measurement and check-in.

IMPORTANT DETAILS:

- The property opens at <u>7:00am Saturday, Sunday and Monday</u>. DO NOT ARRIVE PRIOR
 TO THIS TIME. The gate will be CLOSED until this time.
- Measuring (if needed) will start half an hour prior to the first dog on the line each day.
 Note that there will NOT be a VMO on site for the competition. Dogs needing to be measured will receive measurements good only for the day of the competition, and must be measured prior to running, or scores earned will not be valid.

• TIMETABLE:

- o **SATURDAY, SUNDAY and MONDAY:** Judge's briefing will be at 7:40am, walkthroughs for the first class will begin at 7:45 am each day, and **first dog on** the line at 8:00 am.
- FOOD SERVICES: There is no food on site, please plan accordingly.

CHECK YOUR ENTRIES! - Failure to do so can result in VOID scores. Show managers will NOT correct your information on site as we have way too many other things to process, so please email us (showmanager@daisypeel.com) PRIOR to the show for any corrections.

- AKC: Is your dog number correct?
- AKC: Is your level for everything correct?
- AKC: Is your dog's jump height correct?
- AKC: Is your dog in regular or preferred?

TRIAL SITE RULES:

- The show site is indoors on ARTIFICIAL TURF. Please bring your own crate, clean up supplies, & water for your dog.
- Spectator seating will be allowed in the first 10' of the arena. Dogs are not allowed on the turf unless they are running or queuing to run.
- Please only wear Clean Shoes on the turf.
- No food or liquids aside from water in a closed container are permitted on the turf area.
 Only Non-crumbly dog treats in a sealed container may be brought on the turf area.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times, except when in the ring. Exercise and toilet your
 dog in designated areas. Please poop and scoop and use garbage containers outside on
 the site. Please be courteous to others using the area. No aggressive dogs.
- A warm up jump on turf will be provided for all exhibitors, located in the indicated stall.

 One dog in the warm up stall at a time.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement
- This is a NON SMOKING event. Smoking is not permitted inside of the building or near the doors.
- No weapons of any kind, concealed or otherwise, are allowed on the premises.
- Please comply with ALL of our wonderful parking attendant's instructions. Please park
 ONLY in designated parking areas.

BIS - The Buckeye Bulldog Club does allow bitches in season to compete at this event. Bitches in season must be identified outside the ring with visible panties. BIS will run in normal run order and must start on a mat provided by Agility Challenge Acres. **BIS may not run** in panties, pants, or diapers at any time on course. CRATING:

Crating is available inside the building in 10'x10' stalls (dirt flooring). Dogs must be kenneled or crated while in the stalls. <u>Volunteers</u> will be given first priority for stall crating and stalls must be shared amongst competitors (plenty of room in each stall for multiple crates!!).

UNDERSTAND THE RULES FOR FEO/NFC:

You may turn any run into a FEO/NFC run, but you must declare this before you start. You may use a toy but it cannot leave your hand. You may use this time for any type of training, as long as you are not abusive to your dog. A competition run that has been faulted may NOT be turned into an NFC run. FEO runs will be allowed 45 seconds (per AKC Regulations Chapter 1 section 21). If a handler chooses to train their start line, the time will be started once the handler begins to walk back towards their dog once they have left him. Scribe will announce when time is up and the handler MUST immediately exit the ring.

RESULTS / MAPS / RUN ORDERS:

- RESULTS will be posted in a binder on the results table. We suggest taking a photo of the
 results to allow everybody to see results in a timely manner. Individual results will be

- COURSE MAPS will only be released when doors open. Maps will be posted on The
 Agility Challenge Acres FB page, and posted on the wall inside the Agility Challenge
 Arena in the crating area. **Course maps for the WTBE will be released ONLY once the
 course building for the class has started**
- **RUN ORDERS** Please see the preliminary run order that will be <u>posted on Monday the</u> <u>week of the show</u> on the Agility Challenge Acres website <u>HERE</u> under Event Documents. Any conflicts will have a 5 minute maximum transition time between dogs. We can adjust run order via written corrections for conflicts in all other runs. Please be conscientious when requesting to move dogs as it is likely that somebody ELSE is relying on you and your dog to space out THEIR runs \bigcirc
- AGILITYGATE APP We will be using AGILITY GATE at this trial. The Code will be 0830.
 Agility gate is an app for your phone and can be <u>downloaded in the app store</u> for Apple or Android devices.

WORLD TEAM BYE EVENT Sunday August 31st

Combined scores from J2 (#2) ISC Jumpers and A2 Standard classes (indicated by ** above) on Sunday August 31st will be used to award the Combined ISC Class Award and the World Team Tryouts Bye. To be eligible for the Combined ISC Class Award the team must have a minimum of one clean ISC run and a run that has a maximum of 5 course faults (no time faults allowed) for those scores to be used to compute the Combined Score. If the winning dog in any given jump height does not meet the FCI jump heights, the award DOES NOT go to the first eligible dog. If no FCI-eligible dog meets the requirements for Combined Class Award, the Bye award is not given. The Combined Class winners that meet the FCI jump height cut offs from the 12, 16, 20 and 24 inch heights are invited to attend the AKC/USA World Team Tryouts. They do not need to fulfill any other performance requirements. The team must send in all the required information with the fees and the entry form and meet all the other basic eligibility noted in the WTT document (including an approved pedigree). The handler at tryouts must be the same handler that won the Combined Class Award.
