- All entries, requests for move-up, etc. are promptly responded to. If you do not receive a response within 48 hours during the work week, please email Courtney.
- Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address (max 10 entries per envelope). No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted that specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- Entries must be submitted on Official AKC-form with correct entry-fees listed. One dog per form. **Please read the section: "Class changes effective January 1, 2020," posted in the premium, for instructions when entering same dog in multiple heights or mixed regular and preferred classes.**
- Agreement on back of form MUST be signed. Photo-copies must be legible with original signature. Max 10 entries (dogs) per envelope (includes Express-mail-entries).
- Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Be sure to include correct fees. Overpayments less than \$10 will not be refunded

Paper entries received within 24 hours of the opening date & time limit must:

- 1) Include postage or be metered. **No hand, emailed or faxed deliveries in the first 24 hours.**

This trial is accepting online entries through LabTestedOnline.com. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows. 150 runs online (50%), 150 runs paper (50%) each day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hour period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

OBSTACLES RING CONDITIONS

Course WALK-THROUGHS AND Warm-Up INFORMATION Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

Obstacles

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. **Per AKC revisions, effective February 1, 2023, FCI style broad jump will be used at this event. FCI Tire heights will be used at this event. The wall jump and FCI style broad jump used at this event will be soft construction.**

Equipment

The equipment for this event is provided by Agility Challenge Acres.

MIXED HEIGHT ENTRIES

Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day. Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR INTERNATIONAL SWEEPSTAKES CLASS (ISC)

Purpose: The International Sweepstakes Class (ISC) is a non-regular class providing the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various International Style Standard and Jumpers with Weaves courses. The rules for this class are generally based on international rules. The variety in International Agility course designs is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the "Challenge of the Day" when competing in the ISC class. The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult, or simply different from what is currently allowed in Excellent / Master Class. Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC Website (<https://www.akc.org>).

Eligibility: ISC classes are open to dogs that are eligible to compete in AKC agility trials. There is no Preferred Option for ISC; *dogs may enter at their preferred jump height, however they will be scored against the regular division dogs jumping the same jump height.*

Jump Heights: **DOGS MAY BE ENTERED IN THEIR REGULAR JUMP HEIGHTS**, however, only those dogs running in the 12", 16", 20" and 24" class that meet the FCI/ISC measuring cutoff (different than regular AKC cutoffs) may use their clean run toward the required qualification toward entering WTT or EOTT. Please see the EO/AWC Tryout Rules for further details.

The FCI/ISC cutoffs for those heights are as follows:

- Small (12" jump height) – for dogs measuring 13 ¾" or less at the withers
- Medium (16" jump height) – for dogs measuring more than 13 ¾" and up to 16 7/8" at the withers
- Intermediate (20" jump height) – for dogs measuring more than 16 7/8 but less than 18 7/8" at the withers.
- Large (24" jump height) – for dogs measuring over 18 7/8" at the withers

AWARDS, RIBBONS AND PRIZE INFORMATION

Awards

Awards for qualifying scores only. All awards must be claimed at the show. Ribbons will be awarded to first through fourth place in each height division in each class.

First Place: Rose Ribbon ~ Second Place: Brown Ribbon ~ Third Place: Light Green Ribbon
Fourth Place: Gray Ribbon ~ Qualifying Score: Dark Green Ribbon

CRATING INFORMATION

Crating is allowed in the building in the stalls. Each stall is 10'x10' & can hold at least four dogs. Stall priority is given to volunteers. Please reach out to Daisy at daisy@daisypeel.com to volunteer & check your confirmation after entry for a link to a Google Spreadsheet with volunteer assignments. **Front gate will remain closed until 1 hour prior to 1st dog on the line on Saturday (see final confirmations for details).** There are fast food restaurants, stores, etc. within 15-20 minutes of the show site. **NO Onsite food vendors.** Please plan accordingly.

ELIGIBILITY AND HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained PAL/ILP numbers from the American Kennel Club, aggressive dogs, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. **Mixed breed dogs** listed in the AKC Canine Partners program are eligible to enter this all-breed AKC agility trial. Mixed breed dogs entered in these events must list the breed name as "Canine Partner" (mixed breed) and not as a breed hybrid and must include their AKC Canine Partners number on the entry form and check the AKC No. Box.

Jump Height Information

All dogs without height cards will have to be measured by the judge of record, except 24"/24C" dogs. If a VMO or an AKC Representative is available, all dogs without height cards, including 24"/24C" dogs, will need to be measured. When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dogs on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. For complete details on the Jump Height Card Process go to [this link](#) to read more about it on the AKC website

Eligible dogs may be entered in any level of ISC (Grade 1, 2, or 3). At present, there are no eligibility requirements for any level of ISC and any dog that is eligible according to the above information may run any level. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

EO/ WORLD TEAM TRYOUT QUALIFICATIONS

Clear ISC Agility (Standard) and JWW (Jumpers With Weaves) rounds from any level can be used to fulfill the requirements for the [Team USA European Open Team Tryouts](#). Clear rounds from Levels 2 and 3 can be used to fulfill the requirements for [Team USA Agility World Championships Tryouts](#). Dogs must jump at their international height for ISC scores to count toward Tryouts Qualifications.

SITE INFORMATION AND RULES

The show site is indoors on artificial turf. Please bring your own crate, clean up supplies, & water for your dog. Dogs must be kept on leash when not in the ring, excepting when in the fenced off leash area. A warm up area is available in a special stall in the crating area that has been turfed and has a warm up jump in it. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

Please NO SPIKE SHOES OR HEELS on the turf. Please wear/use clean, athletic footwear to preserve the flooring!

Note that the property gate does not open until 1 hour prior to the first dog on the line.

Please drive slowly (10mph speed limit) on the driveway so as to avoid bunnies, people, and dogs at play. When you enter the driveway, keep right once you have passed through the gate – follow any signs or persons who are directing you to parking.

ENTERING FOR EXHIBITION ONLY (FEO)

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered at any level (Novice, Open Excellent or Masters) in FAST, JWW, Standard or Premier classes. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.
- Course time for FEO in Time 2 Beat, JWW, Standard, Premier and ISC will be 45 seconds. FAST courses times for each class/height are as noted in the Regulations.

FIX AND GO ON (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

Important Information for Exhibitors

- All owners and handlers are responsible for correctly entering and participating in this trial in accordance with AKC rules. Owners are responsible for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. AKC does not permit pinch/prong collars, electrical or special training collars anywhere on the trial grounds.
- The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the AKC agility program, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Confirmation of entry and a schedule of judging time will be sent to the address (email will be used when provided on the entry form) on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, the trial secretary should be contacted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. If a check is returned, the entry will be deemed invalid, and the issuer will be billed for all trial associated fees, including, but not limited to: AKC fees, judges fees and secretarial fees. **Envelopes/transactions containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry.**
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement form included are not acceptable.
- The Buckeye Bulldog Club, Agility Challenge Acres, Daisy Peel, George Mariakis, and Daisy Creative LLC assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.
- The Buckeye Bulldog Club may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Please clean up after your dogs while on the show grounds and at the motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.
- Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under the AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

WAIT LIST

Wait List for Withdrawn Entries after the Closing Date/Time: This trial is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 20 runs/10 exhibitor entries will be placed on the club's wait list. **All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the closing date.** Any entry withdraw requests received by 8 am the Wednesday, ONE WEEK BEFORE the trial weekend will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a waitlisted entry, a refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry minus a \$5 processing fee. Waitlisted entries that do not move off the wait list into the trial by Wednesday @ 8 am ONE WEEK BEFORE the trial weekend will receive a refund.

BIS, INJURY, AND REFUND INFORMATION

BIS - Effective as of May 1, 2025, Bitches in season are allowed to compete in ISC only trials at the discretion of the club. Buckeye Bulldog Club WILL allow bitches in season to compete. Bitches in season must be identified outside the ring with visible panties. BIS will run in normal run order and must start on a mat provided by Agility Challenge Acres. **BIS may not** run in panties, pants, or diapers at any time on course. Refunds – There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date except for entered canine injury/illness (see below). Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, excused, disqualified, or barred from the competition by action of the Show Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. There is a \$5.00 processing fee for **ALL** refunds. **No refunds for overpayments of \$10 or less.**

Injury/Illness – Dogs that cannot compete prior to the set of trials due to an injury/illness will be refunded the entry fee, less \$5.00 per run, upon written certification from a veterinarian. Notification with documentation from veterinarian must be in the hands of the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start time on the first day of the event. Validation of the injury/illness must be made by a licensed veterinarian. Requests from, massage/physical therapists, etc will not be accepted. Handler illness/injury is excluded from this policy.

2026 FIDELIS CUP SCORING AND PRIZE MONEY

The Fidelis Cup is intended to reward **overall performance, speed, and control**, not a single run.

Prize money is awarded **daily**, based on combined performance across multiple classes. Each event weekend (Saturday/Sunday) offers **up to \$1,000 total prize money (\$500 per day)**.

Eligibility

- The handler and dog team must be the same across all classes entered.
- Competitors may enter any or all eligible classes. However, only the **best four (4) weighted run scores** will be used.
- **All classes are eligible for prize money scoring:**
Agility: A1, A2, A3 **Jumping:** J2-1, J2-2, J3
- To be eligible for prize money on a given day, a dog must have **at least one non-eliminated (non-E) run** in an eligible class. Dogs with no non-eliminated runs are not eligible for prize money and will not be ranked.

Daily Combined Scoring

For each dog the **best four (4) weighted run scores** are summed to determine the daily total.

Adjusted Time

Each eligible run is scored using **Adjusted Time**, which combines speed and accuracy:

Adjusted Time = Raw Time + faults

- Standard faults and Refusals will each be scored 5 points each
- Eliminated runs (E) receive **no score**.

Normalized Run Points

To allow fair comparison across different courses, each run is normalized **within its jump height and class**:

Run Points = 100 × (Fastest Adjusted Time ÷ Dog's Adjusted Time)

- The fastest non-eliminated run in each height/class earns 100 points.
- All other runs are scored proportionally.

Level Weighting

Run points are then weighted to reflect course difficulty:

- **Level 1 (A1): × 0.60**
- **Level 2: × 1.00**
- **Level 3: × 1.25**

Placings and Tie-Breakers

Dogs are ranked **within their jump height** by daily combined score.

Ties are broken in the following order:

1. Greater number of Level 3 non-eliminated runs
2. Lower total faults across counted runs
3. Faster adjusted time on the highest-level agility run

Prize Money Allocation

Daily prize money is allocated by jump height based on the **number of unique dogs entered** in eligible classes at that height. If a jump height:

- has no entries, or
- has no eligible scores (all runs eliminated),

then prize money allocated to that height is returned to the **overflow pool** and redistributed.

Any unawarded prize money is redistributed among jump heights with eligible results, proportional to participation at those heights.

Payout Depth

Per jump height:

- **1–4 dogs:** pay 1 place
- **5–9 dogs:** pay 2 places
- **10+ dogs:** pay 3 places

Payout splits:

- **1 place:** 100%
- **2 places:** 65% / 35%
- **3 places:** 50% / 30% / 20%

NOTE: These rules apply to the Fidelis Cup scoring ONLY and do not affect standard class placements, qualifications, or titles.

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners ProgramSM** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
