Welcome! We are excited to have you join us for our **March 14-15, 2026** AKC ISC Competition! Please notify the show managers of any errors in your entries or registration information as soon as possible at [showmanager@daisypeel.com](mailto:showmanager@daisypeel.com). A general briefing will be held after measurement and check-in.

**IMPORTANT DETAILS:**

- The property opens at **8:00am BOTH DAYS. DO NOT ARRIVE PRIOR TO THIS TIME.** The gate will be **CLOSED** until this time.
- Measuring (if needed) will start half an hour prior to the first dog on the line each day. Note that there will NOT be a VMO on site for the competition. Dogs needing to be measured will receive measurements good only for the day of the competition, and must be measured prior to running, or scores earned will not be valid.
- **TIMETABLE:**
  - **SATURDAY & SUNDAY:** Judge's briefing will be at **8:40am**, walkthroughs for the first class will begin at 8:45 am each day, and **first dog on the line at 9:00 am.**
- **FOOD SERVICES:** There is no food on site, please plan accordingly.

**CHECK YOUR ENTRIES!** - Failure to do so can result in VOID scores. Show managers will **NOT** correct your information on site as we have way too many other things to process, so please email us ([showmanager@daisypeel.com](mailto:showmanager@daisypeel.com)) PRIOR to the show for any corrections.

- AKC: Is your dog number correct?
- AKC: Is your level for everything correct?
- AKC: Is your dog's jump height correct?
- AKC: Is your dog in regular or preferred?

**TRIAL SITE RULES:**

- The show site is indoors on ARTIFICIAL TURF. Please bring your own crate, clean up supplies, & water for your dog.
- Spectator seating will be allowed in the first 10' of the arena. Dogs are not allowed on the turf unless they are running or queuing to run.
- Please only wear Clean Shoes on the turf.
- No food or liquids aside from water in a closed container are permitted on the turf area. Only Non-crumblly dog treats in a sealed container may be brought on the turf area.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times, except when in the ring. Exercise and toilet your dog in designated areas. Please poop and scoop and use garbage containers outside on the site. Please be courteous to others using the area. No aggressive dogs.
- A warm up jump on turf will be provided for all exhibitors, located in the indicated stall. One dog in the warm up stall at a time.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement
- This is a NON SMOKING event. Smoking is not permitted inside of the building or near the doors.
- ***No weapons of any kind, concealed or otherwise, are allowed on the premises.***
- ***Please comply with ALL of our wonderful parking attendant's instructions. Please park ONLY in designated parking areas.***

**CRATING:**

- Crating is available inside the building in 10'x10' stalls (dirt flooring). Dogs must be kenneled or crated while in the stalls. ***Volunteers will be given first priority for stall crating*** and stalls must be shared amongst competitors (plenty of room in each stall for multiple crates!!).

**NQ / VOLUNTEER RAFFLE:**

- We will be providing tickets for an NQ as well as a volunteer raffle! Please, please, please help wherever you can to help us have a smooth event! We appreciate every bit of help we can get.

**UNDERSTAND THE RULES FOR FEO/NFC:**

- You may turn any run into a FEO/NFC run, but you must declare this ***before you start***. You may use a toy but it cannot leave your hand. You may use this time for any type of training, as long as you are not abusive to your dog. A competition run that has been faulted may **NOT** be turned into an NFC run. **FEO runs will be allowed 45 seconds (per AKC Regulations Chapter 1 section 21)**. If a handler chooses to train their start line, the time will be started once the handler begins to walk back towards their dog once they have left him. Scribe will announce when time is up and the handler **MUST** immediately exit the ring.

**RESULTS / MAPS / RUN ORDERS:**

- **RESULTS** will be posted in a binder on the results table. We suggest taking a photo of the results to allow everybody to see results in a timely manner. - **COURSE MAPS** will only be released when doors open. Maps will be posted on The Agility Challenge Acres FB page, and posted on the wall inside the Agility Challenge Arena in the crating area.
- **RUN ORDERS** Please see the preliminary run order that will be posted on Monday the week of the show on the Agility Challenge Acres website [HERE](#) under Event Documents. Any conflicts will have a 5 minute maximum transition time between dogs. We can adjust run order via written corrections for conflicts in all other runs. Please be conscientious when requesting to move dogs as it is likely that somebody ELSE is relying on you and your dog to space out THEIR runs 😊
- **AGILITYGATE APP** We will be using AGILITY GATE at this trial. The Code will be 0314. Agility gate is an app for your phone and can be [downloaded in the app store](#) for Apple or Android devices.

## **2026 Fidelus Cup Scoring and Prize Money**

The Fidelus Cup is intended to reward **overall performance, speed, and control**, not a single run.

Prize money is awarded **daily**, based on combined performance across multiple classes. Each event weekend (Saturday/Sunday) offers **up to \$1,000 total prize money (\$500 per day)**.

---

### **Eligibility**

- The handler and dog team must be the same across all classes entered.
- Competitors may enter any or all eligible classes. However, only the **best four (4) weighted run scores** will be used.
- **All classes are eligible for prize money scoring:**
  - Agility:** A1, A2, A3      **Jumping:** J2-1, J2-2, J3
- To be eligible for prize money on a given day, a dog must have **at least one non-eliminated (non-E) run** in an eligible class. Dogs with no non-eliminated runs are not eligible for prize money and will not be ranked.

---

### **Daily Combined Scoring**

For each dog the **best four (4) weighted run scores** are summed to determine the daily total.

#### **Adjusted Time**

Each eligible run is scored using **Adjusted Time**, which combines speed and accuracy:

**Adjusted Time = Raw Time + faults**

- Standard faults and Refusals will each be scored 5 points each
- Eliminated runs (E) receive **no score**.

#### **Normalized Run Points**

To allow fair comparison across different courses, each run is normalized **within its jump height and class**:

**Run Points = 100 × (Fastest Adjusted Time ÷ Dog's Adjusted Time)**

- The fastest non-eliminated run in each height/class earns 100 points.
- All other runs are scored proportionally.

Level Weighting

Run points are then weighted to reflect course difficulty:

- **Level 1 (A1): × 0.60**
- **Level 2: × 1.00**
- **Level 3: × 1.25**

Placings and Tie-Breakers

Dogs are ranked **within their jump height** by daily combined score.

Ties are broken in the following order:

1. Greater number of Level 3 non-eliminated runs
2. Lower total faults across counted runs
3. Faster adjusted time on the highest-level agility run

---

**Prize Money Allocation**

Daily prize money is allocated by jump height based on the **number of unique dogs entered** in eligible classes at that height.

If a jump height:

- has no entries, or
- has no eligible scores (all runs eliminated),

then prize money allocated to that height is returned to the **overflow pool** and redistributed.

Any unawarded prize money is redistributed among jump heights with eligible results, proportional to participation at those heights.

Payout Depth

Per jump height:

- **1–4 dogs:** pay 1 place
- **5–9 dogs:** pay 2 places
- **10+ dogs:** pay 3 places

Payout splits:

- **1 place:** 100%
- **2 places:** 65% / 35%
- **3 places:** 50% / 30% / 20%

NOTE: These rules apply to the Fidelis Cup scoring ONLY and do not affect standard class placements, qualifications, or titles.
